

## **Hope Echoes Week 2**

### **Hope Echoes through Failure**

Text: Hebrews 6:1-3, 9-12

Purpose: No one is immune from failure in work, relationships, or faith. Hope echoes through failure into maturity. What does the gospel say about failure? It's not the end of the story. It's not ultimately what defines you. Failure is not final with God.

Opening Interaction: What's a funny fail story you can share with the group?

Read and Discuss: Hebrews 6:1-3, 9-12

- In this passage, what details seem important? What jumps out at you?
  - What is the author communicating to his audience?
  - What does this passage teach us about God?
1. What kinds of things make someone "mature?" What does maturity have to do with faith?
  2. How do you typically respond to failure?
  3. How have you found hope meet you in moments of failure?
  4. How has God used others to encourage you in low moments?
