## Knowing Jesus Easter

**Text:** Matthew 28:16-20; 1 Corinthians 15:17-19

**Purpose:** Celebrating Easter means celebrating Jesus' resurrection and ascension. We'll look at why these are important, but also discuss some of the doubts that people might have about Easter.

Opening Question: What's your favorite Easter candy?

Read and Discuss: Matthew 28:16-20; 1 Corinthians 15:17-19

- 1. Why do you think "some doubted" in Matthew 28? In what ways do you think people (Christians and non-Christians) struggle with doubt?
- 2. What would you say to someone who says they can't trust that the Bible is accurate? Why do you think the Bible is accurate?
- 3. How does having eyewitness accounts of Jesus' death, resurrection and ascension build your faith?
- 4. In 1 Corinthians 15, why do you think Paul says "if Christ has not been raised, your faith is futile"? What would it mean if Jesus wasn't raised from the dead?
- 5. Why is the resurrection of Jesus so important for our lives?
- 6. What hope do you have because Jesus was raised from the dead?
